*At a regular meeting of the Smith County Commissioners Court held at the Smith County Courthouse Annex,
Tyler, Texas, at which a quorum was present, the following Resolution was adopted:*

WHEREAS, Prairie View A&M University was created as an Agricultural and Mechanical College on August 14, 1876, by the 15th Texas Legislature. The first eight students enrolled and began their studies in 1878; and

WHEREAS, it is the second oldest public institution of higher education in Texas and the third largest Historically Black College/University in the nation. It is designated as an “institution of the first class” in the Texas Constitution. Enrollment exceeds 10,000 students and includes more than 85,000 graduates; and

WHEREAS, as Prairie View A&M University celebrates its 150th anniversary, it remains committed to teaching, research, service and outreach that improve lives and strengthen communities across Texas; and

WHEREAS, the university’s alumni have made an impact domestically and globally with their distinguished public, military and other service and leadership across professions; and

WHEREAS, Prairie View A&M University conducts critical work with its cooperative extension program, which serves more than 75 Texas counties. Prairie View Extension Agents Anthony Brown and Erica Davis work in and serve the citizens of Smith County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Commissioners Court of the County of Smith, Texas, through adoption of this Resolution does hereby proclaim August 14, 2026, as

“Prairie View A&M University Day”

in Smith County and encourages all residents to celebrate its 150th anniversary and service to Texas.
